



WISCONSIN SHORTHORN BREEDERS ASSOCIATION
BY LAWS

ADOPTED February 2, 1992 at Annual Meeting

ARTICLE I The organization shall be known as the Wisconsin Shorthorn Breeders association.

ARTICLE II The purpose of the Wisconsin Shorthorn Breeders Association shall be to promote the interests of Shorthorn Cattle for its membership.

ARTICLE III Any breeder or other interested person may become a member of this association by paying the annual dues.
Each membership (dues payment) entitles the farm or individual one vote.

ARTICLE IV The annual dues of this association shall be determined at the annual meeting. Membership shall include one National Lassie membership per family.

ARTICLE V The board of directors shall consist of 7 members elected for 3-year terms as follows.
1992--2 members
1993--3 members
1994--2 members
A board member may not serve more than two consecutive terms.
In addition the Lassie chairperson and the Junior President shall serve on the board.
Lassie chairperson shall be appointed by the President and approved by the board.

ARTICLE VI The officers of the association shall be President, Vice President, and Secretary-Treasurer. The President and Vice President shall be elected from the current board for 1-year terms at a board meeting immediately following the annual meeting. The Secretary-Treasurer shall be elected annually at the annual meeting.

ARTICLE VII The President shall preside at all meetings and executive board meetings of the association. The Vice President shall preside at meetings in the absence of the President.
The Secretary-Treasurer shall:
a. keep all records of all meetings of the association and executive board.
b. Conduct correspondence as directed by the executive board.
c. Serve as custodian of association finances including:
1. Keep records of receipts and disbursements.

2. Pay bills as directed by executive board.
3. Submit financial report at annual meeting.

ARTICLE VIII The executive board shall have full management of the business affairs of the association. The President may authorize expenditures of up to \$25.00 without board approval when executive board meetings are not practical.

ARTICLE IX The annual meeting of the association shall be held each spring at a place and time to be determined by the executive board. The agenda shall include (but not be limited to):

- A. Minutes of previous annual meeting
- B. Financial report
- C. Election of executive board
- D. Establishment of annual dues
- E. Selection of state fair judges
- F. Selection of site for state picnic
- G. Selection of site for Wisconsin Jr. Show

ARTICLE X These By Laws may be amended by a two-thirds vote of the members present at an annual meeting.
